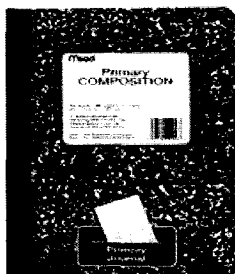

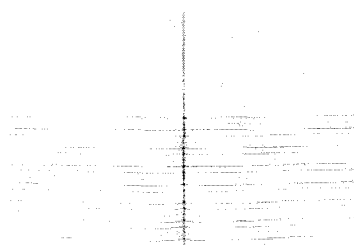
Below you will find the supply list for your child. It would be a good idea for each child to have his/her name on their things to avoid confusion with his/her classmates.

Each student will need the following:

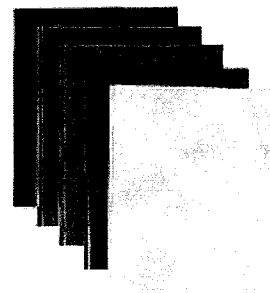
- 3 **primary** journals or 3**primary** composition notebooks (see example)
